POLICY: Ineligibility for Extracurricular Activities

3 OR MORE	AUTOMATICALLY INELIGIBLE FOR 2 WEEKS (MINIMUM) STARTING ON THE 1 ST DAY OF CONFERENCE PERIOD.	SAME AS 1 DEFICIENCY REMAINS INELIGIBLE UNTIL ALL FAILING GRADES ARE REPLACED WITH PASSING GRADES. (REVIEWED EVERY FRIDAY)

Students that participate in extracurricular activities such as athletics, marching band, clubs etc. and have 3 deficiencies will be required to attend regular tutoring sessions scheduled by the teacher and will be also be required to attend practices, meetings and games. The student will be required to maintain their fitness level independently of those practices and will be responsible for what is learned. Students will be required to attend games, dressed in attire deemed appropriate by the coach/advisor, supporting his/her teammates.

CONFERENCE MUST BE ATTENDED BY STUDENT, PARENT AND TEACHER. STUDENT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR SETTING UP THE CONFERENCE.

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PLAN OF ACTION MAY CONSIST OF:

DESCRIPTION OF HOW STUDENT WILL WORK TOWARD IMPROVEMENT, RECEIVE EXTRA HELP DURING SCHOOL AND AFTER SCHOOL, LIST OF ASSIGNMENTS TO BE COMPLETED AND OR EXTRA CREDIT.

IF PLAN OF ACTION IS NOT FOLLOWED, STUDENT WILL IMMEDIATELY BECOME INELIGIBLE.

Notes:

- If failing, must attend tutoring to be eligible for after school activities
- **All** students must complete deficiency conferences to be eligible for after school activities
 - If not completed by date above, student becomes ineligible for after school activities until the next Interim Progress Report (IPR), report card or teacher approval, whichever comes first.
- A list of students ineligible for after school activities will be kept at all events. Students on this list will not be allowed to attend.
- After school activities include sporting events, dances and any other class events. This means participating or watching.
